- 1) Sociable (adj): willing to talk and engage in activities with other people; friendly.
- 2) Paragraph (n): a distinct section of a piece of writing, usually dealing with a single theme and indicated by a new line, indentation, or numbering
- 3) Science (n): the intellectual and practical activity encompassing the systematic study of the structure and behaviour of the physical and natural world through observation and experiment.
- 4) Rhythm (n): a strong, regular, repeated pattern of movement or sound
- 5) Exhilarate (v): make (someone) feel very happy, animated, or elated
- 6) Rustic (adj): relating to the countryside; rural, made in a plain and simple fashion
- 7) Flavoring (n): a substance used to give a different, stronger, or more agreeable taste to food or drink
- 8) Sanitary (adj): relating to the conditions that affect hygiene and health, especially the supply of sewage facilities and clean drinking water.
- 9) Innocent (adj): not guilty of a crime or offense.
- 10) Tongue (n): the fleshy muscular organ in the mouth of a mammal, used for tasting, licking, swallowing, and (in humans) articulating speech.
- 11) Mileage (n): a number of miles traveled or covered.
- 12) Sandwich (n): an item of food consisting of two pieces of bread with meat, cheese, or other filling between them, eaten as a light meal
- 13) Bouquet (n): an attractively arranged bunch of flowers, especially one presented as a gift or carried at a ceremony.
- 14) Cemetery (n): a burial ground; a graveyard.
- 15) Familiar (adj): well known from long or close association, in close friendship
- 16) Advice (n): guidance or recommendations offered with regard to prudent future action.
- 17) Disdain (n): the feeling that someone or something is unworthy of one's consideration or respect; contempt.
- 18) Spacious (adj): (especially of a room or building) having ample space.
- 19) Emphasize (v): give special importance or prominence to (something) in speaking or writing.
- 20) Phrase (n): a small group of words standing together as a conceptual unit, typically forming a component of a clause.
- 21) Advantageous (adj): involving or creating favorable circumstances that increase the chances of success or effectiveness; beneficial.
- 22) Civilize (v): bring (a place or people) to a stage of social and cultural development considered to be more advanced.
- 23) Obviously (adv): in a way that is easily perceived or understood; clearly.
- 24) Souvenir (n): a thing that is kept as a reminder of a person, place, or event.
- 25) Suspicious (adj): having or showing a cautious distrust of someone or something.
- 26) Acquaintance (n): a person one knows slightly, but who is not a close friend.
- 27) Sophomore (n): a second-year college or high school student.
- 28) Vaccinate (v): treat with a vaccine to produce immunity against a disease; inoculate.
- 29) Aptitude (n): a natural ability to do something.

- 30) Illuminate (v): to supply (something) with light : to shine light on (something) : to make (something) clear and easier to understand
- 31) Meticulous (adj): taking or showing extreme care about minute details; precise; thorough
- 32) Disagreement (n): lack of consensus or approval.
- 33) Translucent (adj): (of a substance) allowing light, but not detailed shapes, to pass through; semitransparent.
- 34) Wreck (n/v): destroy or severely damage (a structure, vehicle, or similar), the destruction of a ship at sea; a shipwreck.
- 35) Honestly (adv): in a truthful, fair, or honorable way.
- 36) Cringe (v): to feel disgust or embarrassment and often to show this feeling by a movement of your face or body
- 37) Merrily (adv): in a cheerful way.
- 38) Artificial (adj): made or produced by human beings rather than occurring naturally, especially as a copy of something natural.
- 39) Monotonous (adj): dull, tedious, and repetitious; lacking in variety and interest.
- 40) Apprehensive (adj): anxious or fearful that something bad or unpleasant will happen.
- 41) Immediately (adv): at once; instantly.
- 42) Lightning (n): the occurrence of a natural electrical discharge of very short duration and high voltage between a cloud and the ground or within a cloud, accompanied by a bright flash and typically also thunder.
- 43) Amendment (n): a minor change or addition designed to improve a text, piece of legislation, etc.
- 44) Puny (adj): small and weak.
- 45) Slumber (v): sleep
- 46) Consequently (adv): as a result
- 47) Adjustable (adj): able to be adjusted/changed
- 48) Impending (adj): (of an event regarded as threatening or significant) about to happen; forthcoming.
- 49) Miscellaneous (adj): (of items or people gathered or considered together) of various types or from different sources.
- 50) Endurance (n): the fact or power of enduring an unpleasant or difficult process or situation without giving way.
- 51) Chrysanthemum (n): a plant of the daisy family with brightly colored ornamental flowers, existing in many cultivated varieties.
- 51) Questionnaire (n): a set of printed or written questions with a choice of answers, devised for the purposes of a survey or statistical study.
- 53) Psychology (n): the scientific study of the human mind and its functions, especially those affecting behavior in a given context.
